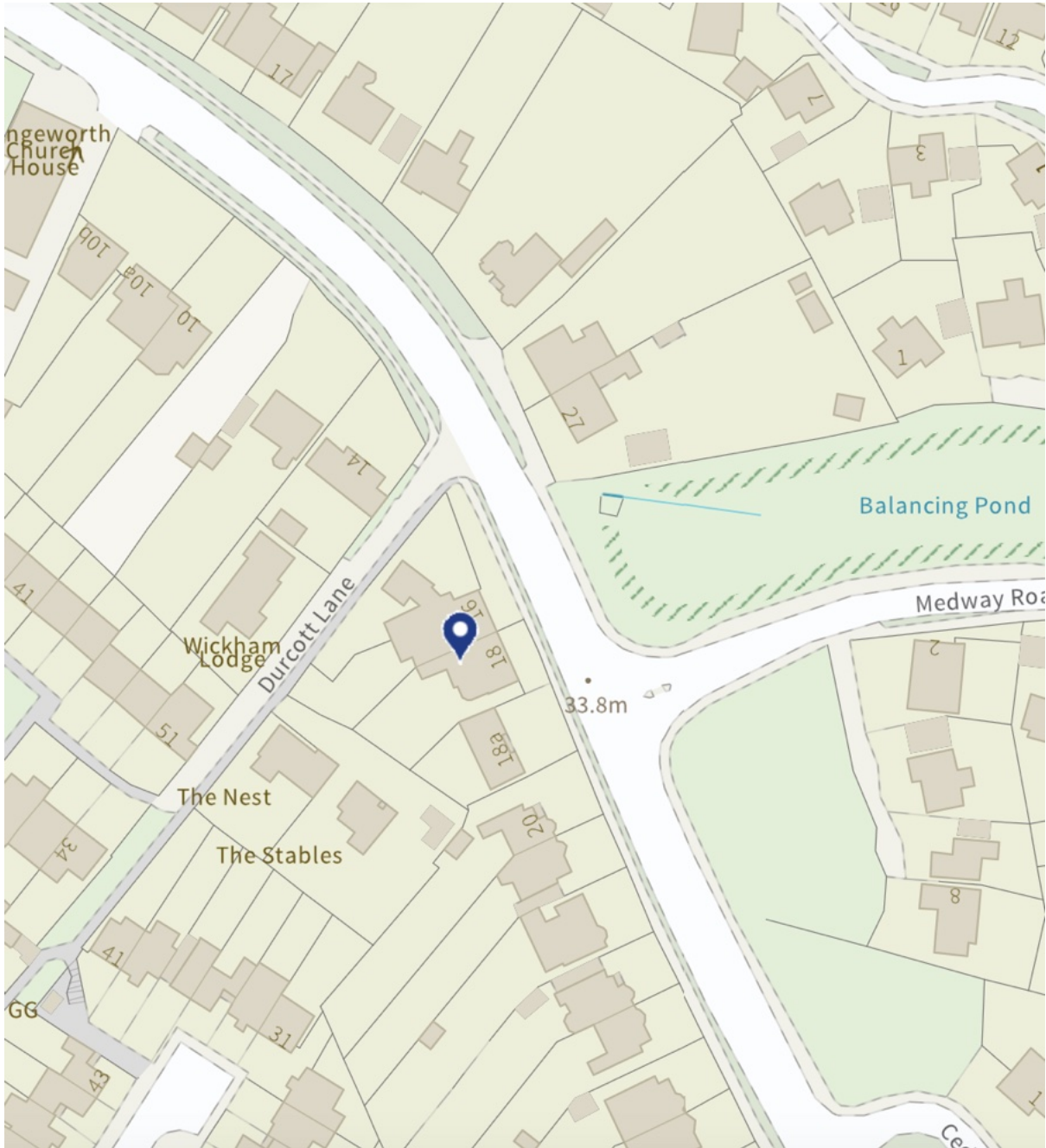

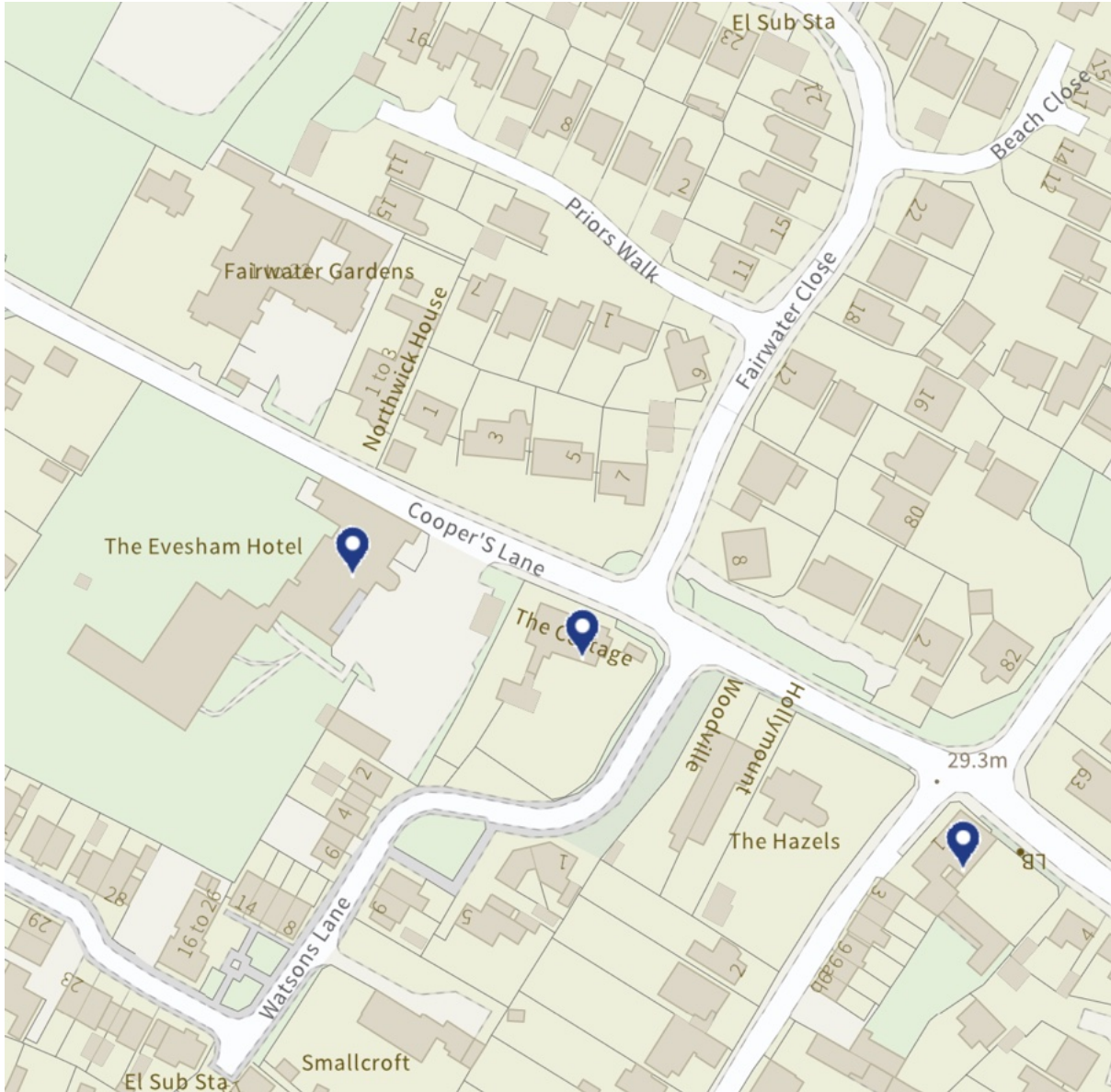

Address 16 & 18 Broadway Road

Grade II Date listed 23 June 1977

Description:

C18 and later. Engraved stucco; 2 storeys; 2 rush windows each, those to No 16 generally renewed; paired doorways, with altered doors, under good early C19 cast iron porch, having up-swept pediment. No 16 has a later C19 splayed bay window. Tiles.

Address Durcott House, Coopers Lane

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C16 with later alterations. Rubble; 2 storeys; 3 sash windows, the lowers with restored stone hood moulds; altered plain doorway with rectangular fanlight and 6-panelled door. C19 tripartite windows to ground storey; blocked stone mullioned window in gabled end to north; coped gabled ends with kneelers; renewed stone stacks; modern slate roof.

Address Prospect House and School House, 4 Badsey Road

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

House, now 2 houses. c.1820 with later C19 additions to rear and minor C20 alterations. Red brick in Flemish bond with hipped slate roofs, behind parapet at facade. Brick chimneystacks. 2-storey house with set back wing that forms part of the late-C20 conversion to 2 houses. EXTERIOR: Garden elevation of 3 bays. Ground floor has central entrance with later part-glazed moulded door and semi-circular portico with slender Tuscan columns, flanked by semi-circular bay windows with 4-over-4 and 6-over-6 paned sashes divided by Tuscan pilasters. First floor has 8-over-8 paned sashes in moulded architraves with cills on brackets, the central with semi-circular wrought iron balustrade. Moulded stucco eaves cornice below parapet along front elevation. Set back to right, additional bay with similar windows at ground and first floor. Set back further to right, later-C19 wing with 2 casements with overlights to each floor, dentilled eaves, hipped slate roof and end chimneystack. Rear elevation of original range includes central stair window under rounded arch, sash windows with horns at first floor.

Address Knowle Hill Manor, Badsey Lane

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C18 and later. Roughcast; 2 storeys plus attic; a 2-light sash window to left, a semi-circular headed at centre, and a splayed bay window on right, fitted with sashes and tiered over ground and 1st storeys; small gable at centre; plain doorway with later part-glazed door and wood rustic porch; hipped dormer on south side. 2-storeyed outbuilding attached on left-hand side has dormer window breaking below eaves. Corbelled eaves; old tiles. C19 bay at rear with slate pentice roof.

Address Bengeworth Fields Farmhouse, Badsey Road

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18. Plain house of red brick with tile roof. L-shaped on plan; 3 storeys; 3 casement windows with shallow segmental heads; plain doorway with rectangular fanlight and glazed modern porch. Projecting wing at rear.
