Address 1-3 Waterside

Grade II

Date listed 23 June 1977

Description:

Early C19, the core probably earlier. Roughcast. No 1 is of 3 storeys, Nos 2 and 3 being of two storeys plus attic; eight sash windows in flush frames, those to second storey of No 1 with horizontal sliding sashes; dog-tooth and plain eaves; tiles and slates. Later doors and three C19 small shop fronts with modern glazing.

Nos 1 to 10 (consec) form a group.

Address 4-9 Waterside

Grade II

Date listed 23 June 1977

Description:

Early C19 terraced range. Stucco; 2 storeys plus attic; 8 sash windows grouped; dentilled eaves cornice; slates. Plain recessed doorway to No 7. Segmental headed carriage arch between Nos 8 and 9; modern shop fronts elsewhere.

Nos 1 to 10 (consec) form a group.

Address 10 Waterside

Grade II

Date listed 23 June 1977

Description:

Early C19 and later. Roughcast; 2 storeys plus attic; later C19 canted oriel to 1st storey; slates. Modern shop front. Included for group value.

Address Northwick Arms Hotel, Waterside

Grade II

Date listed 23 June 1977

Description:

Early/mid C19. Painted brick and stucco; 3 storeys, the ground storey rusticated; chamfered quoins at sides; slight central projection (one window) with pediment; 7 sash windows overall, with keyblocks and channelled lintels. Ground storey has some renewed tripartite windows, 2 plain doorways with rectangular fanlights (that on right-hand side plain) and 4-panelled divided doors, and cornice hoods on console brackets. Bold moulded wood eaves; hipped slate roof.
