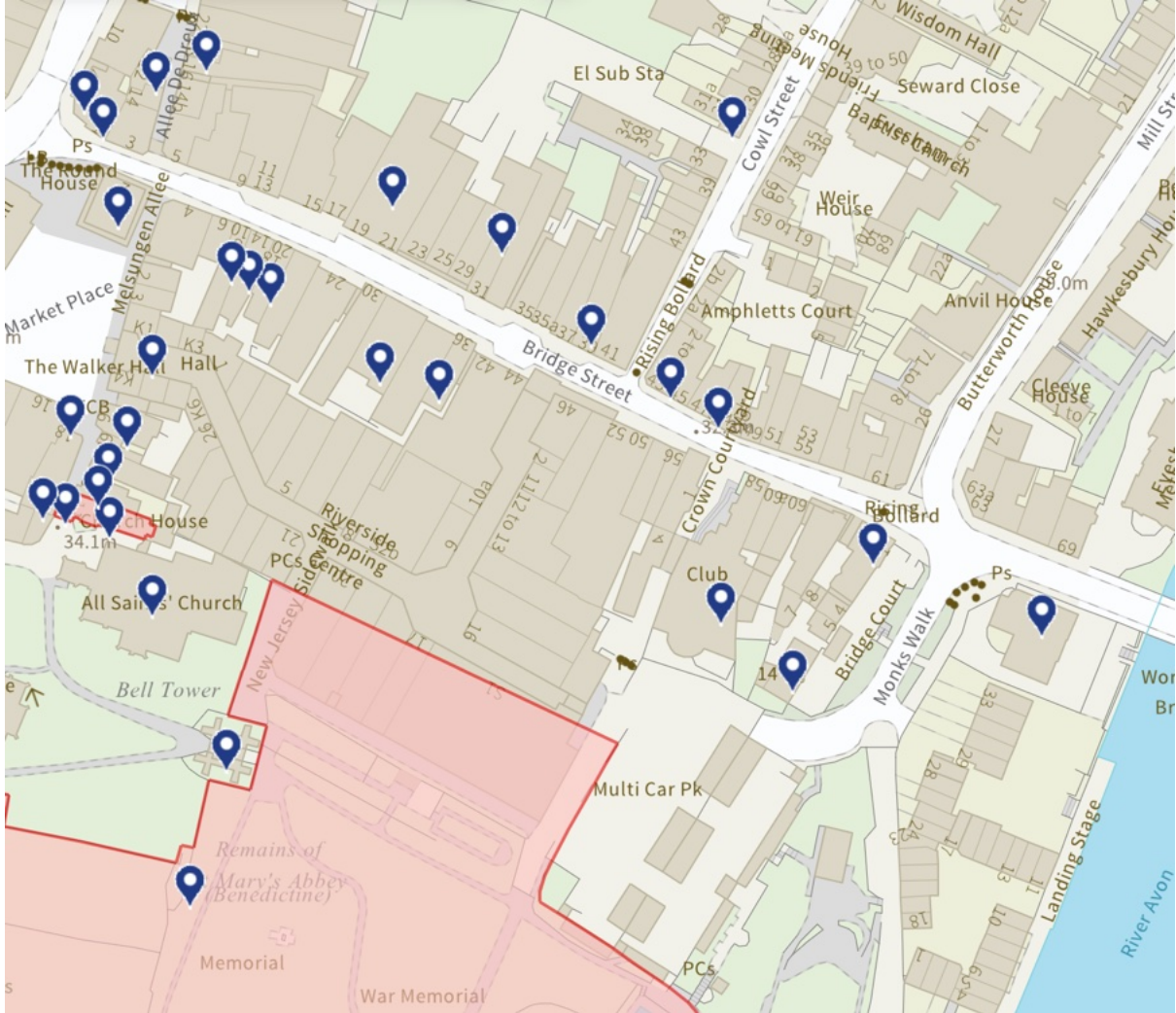

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18. Red brick; 1 sash window with diagonal pattern glazing bars, and flat brick arches; parapet. Modern shop front.

Part of a group 8-22 Bridge Street.

Address 12-18 Bridge Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 4 sash windows with diagonal pattern glazing bars, and flat brick arches; band at 2nd storey; altered eaves replacing former modillion cornice; tiles. Modern shop fronts.

Part of a group 8-22 Bridge Street.

Address 20-22 Bridge Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952; amended 24 June 1977

Description:

C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 3 sash windows with flat brick arches and moulded keyblocks; grooved quoins at sides; moulded eaves cornice; parapet with open balustrade surmounted by urns. Modern shop fronts.

Address 21 Bridge Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952; amended 24 June 1977

Description:

C18. Brick. 3 storeys. 3 slight segmental bows with 3-light double hung sash windows, cornice. Parapet and blocking course. Modern shop front.

Address 31-33 Bridge Street

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952; amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Early C19. Engraved stucco to probable earlier core; 3 storey; 4 sash windows in plain dog-eared architraves; 5 windows to 2nd storey; part cornice end part parapet. Modern shop fronts.

Address 32 Bridge Street – listed as Midland Bank

Grade II Date listed 6 May 1977

Description:

C18. Facade well restored in Georgian style. Red brick; 3 storeys; pilasters at sides; 5 sash windows with triangular and segmental pediments alternating; good moulded lead rainwater heads and downpipes; moulded brick cornice at 1st floor and at eaves; panelled parapet. Ground storey has bank windows in facsimile and a pilaster doorway at either side with segmental pediment.

Address 36 Bridge Street

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 1 tripartite window with renewed sashes, and canted oriel to 1st storey (no glazing bars) all with flat brick arches; parapet. Modern shop front.

Address 37-41 Bridge Street

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18/early C19. Red brick; 3 storeys; 7 sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels; stone chamfered long and short quoins at sides of No 41. Modern shop fronts.

Address 43-45 Bridge Street

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; long and short quoins at sides; 4 sash windows with fluted keyblocks and flat brick arches; sill band; modillion eaves cornice; parapet. Modern shop fronts. Returned side to Cowl Street has 6 windows (some blocked) with channelled lintels.

Nos 37 to 47 (odd) form a group.

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18. Restored. Red brick; three storeys; four sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels; plain eaves; slates. Modern shop fronts.

Nos 37 to 47 (odd) form a group.

Address 58 Bridge Street formally listed as the Crown Hotel

Grade **II*** Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Partly medieval, much restored with C18 and C19 alterations and modern additions. Centre, of 2 storeys plus attic, is set back from street at rear of courtyard; long 2-storeyed projecting wings at either side with gabled ends oversailing on heavy wood brackets. Painted cement throughout. Centre wing has 2 wide windows with horizontal sliding casements and coupled pilasters at sides; covered way to right with exposed timber beams above; splayed bay in left hand angle (1 window) with C19 plain pilaster doorcase, entablature and later divided door; 2 gabled dormers; slates. Wings have plain sash windows, that on left-hand side with inset modern shop front on gabled end. Originally enclosed courtyard of the typical medieval inn, of which this is a rare example. Unoccupied (1976). Interior not inspected but said to be of interest.

Address 64 Bridge Street – former barn at the rear

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C16 or C17. Timber-frame with brick infilling; 2 storeys; 2 modern casement windows on east side; tiles. Disused and in need of repair when inspected (1976).

Address 64 Bridge Street

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Street frontage early-mid C19. Stucco; 2 storeys; 3 sash windows in cement architraves; slates. Modern shop front. Return elevation shows some restored rubble walling to ground storey, a 2-storey brick portion with 3 modern casement windows, and a C16 or C17 timber-framed wing with hipped roof, part stone-tiled, part asbestos.

Address Avonbridge House

Grade II Date listed 16 March 1973 amended 16 March 1977

Description:

C16 or C17. Timber-frame with brick infilling; 2 storeys; 2 modern casement windows on east side; tiles. Disused and in need of repair when inspected (1976). Architraves with keyblocks; sill band; moulded cornice at 1st floor; central doorway with Roman Doric porch; 2 dormers with segmental pediments; pseudo quoins at sides; dentilled modillion eaves cornice; hipped slate roof. One-window bay on right-hand side with arched doorway. Cast iron railings to sunken forecourt. Modern one-storey addition at rear.
