Address 17 Oat Street listed as the Green Dragon Inn

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18 or early C19 to earlier timber frame. Stucco; 2 storeys; 3 sash windows. Ground storey has 4 sash windows and one 3-light window on right hand side; plain doorway with modern door; plain eaves; tiles. Interior much altered but retains some exposed ceiling beams.

Address 18-19 Cowl Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

C16. Timber frame, exposed on left-hand wing; two storeys plus attic; generally faced in roughcast; overhang at first floor; three modern casement windows, two gabled dormers; gable on right-hand side with good carved bargeboards; tiles. Altered ground storey.

Address 32 Cowl Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C19 painted cement to earlier timber frame, partly revealed internally; 2 storeys and later attic; 2 C19 casement windows; plain doorway and modern door; casement window to shop; tiles. Interior has exposed timber frame to 1st storey and ground storey partition.

The record made in 1992 was for the wrong building.

Address Unitarian Chapel, Oat Street

Grade **II***

Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

1737. Stone chapel in Renaissance manner. Pilasters to full height; semi-circular headed windows; doorway with keyblock, semi-elliptical head, later divided door, and stone porch with pediment. Hipped tile roof. Interior has C18 pews and pulpit.

Address 27 Swan Lane included with 1-12 Rynal Street

Grade II

Date listed 30 September 1969

Description:

Including No 27 Swan Lane. Early C19 terraced range. Red brick; 2 storeys; pointed arched windows with keyblocks and "Gothic" glazing bars. No 27 Swan Lane is a slightly more important house of 3 storeys with 2 sash windows having keyblocks and channelled lintels.

Address Rynal Cottage, 14 Rynal Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

C17. Timber frame and painted brick with gabled end to north sham painted timber frame and cement; 2 storeys; 3 later sash windows, that at centre renewed. Ground storey has simple doorway with flush-panelled door, and early C19 splayed bay window on right-hand side. Tiles. Early C19 addition on left hand side.
