## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 2 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18 or early C19. Stucco; 3 storeys; convex front to street corner; 3 sash windows (the central window of each storey blocked) with channelled lintels; moulded stucco eaves cornice; tiles. Modern shop fronts.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 12 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*C17 with later alterations. Timber frame exposed at 1st storey on north and east sides; 2 storeys; gabled end to north with C19 canted bay window tiered over both storeys; 1st floor overhang on east side supported on later wood brackets; projecting eaves; hipped tile roof. Ground storey altered and with modern shop on east side.*

Address 16-20 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 2 sash windows (single glazing bars only) with keyblocks and channelled lintels; moulded stone eaves; slates. Square headed passage-way on left-hand side.*

Address Anchor House, 30-32 High Street

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C19. Stucco; 2 storeys; 4 large plate glass windows divided by cast iron moulded columns; moulded parapet with large anchor; eaves cornice and balustrade surmounted by acroteria blocks and urn finials. Modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 30 to 46 (even) and No 50 form a group.*

Address 34-36 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Painted and engraved stucco; 3 storeys; 4 renewed sash windows with moulded keyblocks and channelled lintels; long and short chamfered quoins at sides; parapet. Modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 30 to 46 (even) and No 50 form a group.*

Address 38 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Painted and engraved stucco; 3 storeys; 3 sash windows with moulded keyblocks and channelled lintels; long and short quoins on left-hand side only; parapet. Late C19 restaurant front.*

*Nos 30 to 46 (even) and No 50 form a group.*

Address 40-44 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Engraved stucco; 3 storeys; 5 sash windows with moulded keyblocks; quoins at sides; plain pilaster doorcase with rectangular fanlight, entablature, cornice, and 6-panelled door. Inset modern shop fronts at either side. Moulded eaves cornice; parapet.*

*Nos 30 to 46 (even) and No 50 form a group.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 46-50 High Street listed as Barclays Bank

Grade II Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Restored. Engraved stucco; 3 storeys; 6 sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels; ground storey rusticated; pseudo-quoins at sides; parapet. Modern bank windows to ground storey in earlier moulded surrounds with keyblocks and shaped heads; angled semi-circular headed doorway on left-hand side with Tuscan columns supporting entablature.*

*Nos 30 to 46 (even) and No 50 form a group.*

Address 58-60 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 19 February 1970

### Description:

*Early C17 with later alterations. Engraved stucco; 2 storeys; 4 rush windows; tiles. Inset modern shop fronts. Interior of No 58 has knee brace trusses exposed at 1st storey with traces of Elizabethan painting. There are larger Elizabethan paintings on the end wall to south concealed behind modern panelling.*

*Nos 58 to 66 (even) and former Barn at rear of No 66 form a group.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 62 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 2 sash windows with keyblocks and plain lintels; moulded pilaster doorcase with traceried fanlight and open pediment; slates. Semi-elliptical headed archway on right-hand side.*

*Nos 58 to 66 (even) and former Barn at rear of No 66 form a group.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 64 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18/early C19. Cement rendered brick front; 3 storeys; 3 windows, Venetian with semi-circular heads, keyblocks and flat architraves, modern glazing; bands at 1st and 2nd floors; pseudo quoins at sides; dentilled eaves cornice; tiles. Modern shop front.*

*Nos 58 to 66 (even) and former Barn at rear of No 66 form a group.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 66 High Street listed as Star Hotel, now The Old Swanne Inne

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Early C18. The core probably earlier. Brick faced in stucco; 2 storeys; stone plinth; 5 sash windows; gabled feature at centre with ball-head finial; projecting hipped wing on left-hand side of 5 storey and with 2 windows; long and short chamfered quoins; moulded pilaster doorcase with side lights, radial fanlight with figure-head keyblock, and modern divided door.*

*Nos 58 to 66 (even) and former Barn at rear of No 66 form a group.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 86 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Early C19 engraved stucco to earlier timber frame revealed in covered-way on left-hand side; 3 storeys; 2 modern casement windows to 1st storey and 3 small-paned windows to 2nd storey having horizontal sliding sashes; tiles. Altered ground storey.*

## The Listed Buildings of Evesham, including Hampton.

Address 88 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Early C19. Stucco; 2 storeys; giant fluted Ionic pilasters at either side rising over both storeys; 4 sash windows in moulded architraves; eaves cornice and blocking course; doorway with Regency porch. Wrought iron railings overall to small forecourt.*
