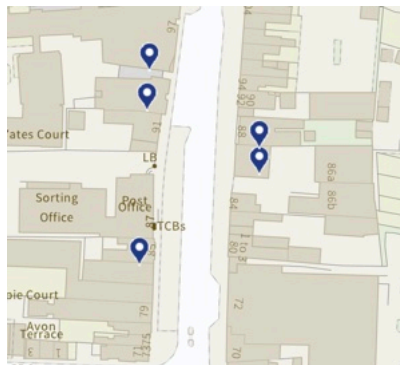
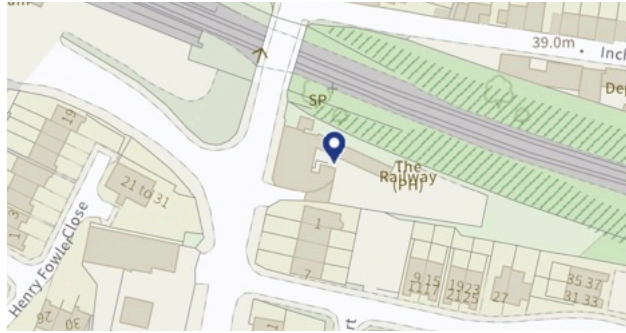

Address 3-5 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; long and short stone chamfered quoins at sides; 2 sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels, and one canted oriel on right-hand side; parapet. Modern shop front.*

*Nos 3 to 11 (odd) form a group.*

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*C18. Faced in roughcast; 2 storeys plus attic; 2 canted oriel window; 2 gabled dormers. Modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 3 to 11 (odd) form a group.*

Date listed 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C16. Timber frame with close set studding and plaster infilling; 2 storeys; 2 sash windows in moulded cases; tiles. Modern shop front.*

### Description:

*Late C18. Stucco; 3 storeys; band; 4 sash windows; good doorway with wide radial fanlight, side lights and hood on consoles; parapet.*

### Description:

*C18. Stucco; 3 storeys; long and short quoins at sides; 2 sash windows in moulded architraves; slates (now felt covered). Late C19 shop fronts with modern glazing.*

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Early C19. Painted stucco, the ground storey rusticated; 3 storeys; 3 sash windows in moulded architraves and with blind balustrades below; band; slates. Nos 45 and 47 have inserted modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 45 to 51 (odd), Railings and lamp standards of No 51 and Nos 55 to 69 (odd) form a group.*

### Description:

*Good original wrought iron railings to forecourt with a return at either side and at sides of steps to entrance, which incorporate a pair of lamp standards.*

### Description:

*Good house dated 1692. Russet brick; 5 sash windows, that at centre of 2nd storey with open pediment; moulded brick bands at 1st and 2nd storeys; stone long and short chamfered quoins at sides; good moulded lead rainwater head at 1st floor with above date; central doorway in stuccoed surround with plain pilasters, moulded wood doorcase with radial fanlight, 5 fielded-panelled door, moulded wood dentilled cornice hood on large elaborate wrought iron scrolled brackets rising from railings (qv) and stone steps up. Moulded wood modillion eaves cornice; slates. Interior: Good contemporary features comprising staircase with twisted balusters, pine and oak panelling, door casings and doors in ground storey rooms and angled fireplace in room to left of entrance with carved pine over-mantel. Projecting to rear at south side is a large 2-storey C18 wing (undergoing restoration, 1976) which contains 4 Adam fireplaces and moulded plaster ceilings.*

### Description:

*C18. Painted and engraved stucco; 3 storeys; quoins at sides and at centre; 5 sash windows (plus a blocked window at centre of 1st and 2nd storeys) with channelled lintels, those to No 55 with keyblocks; parapet; hipped tile roof. Modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 45 to 51 (odd). Railing and lamp standards of No 51 and Nos 55 to 69 (odd) form a group.*

Address 59-61 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Late C18/early C19, the core probably earlier. Stucco fronts; low 2 storeys; 3 three-light sash windows (no glazing bars). No 61 has painted oval wood plaque with insignia and inscribed "Bootmaker by appointment to HRH the late Duc D'Aumale and HRH Duchess D'Aosta" (the seat of Duc d'Aumale was at Woodnorton). Slates. Late C19 and modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 45 to 51 (odd). Railing and lamp standards of No 51 and Nos 55 to 69 (odd) form a group.*

### Description:

*Late C18/early C19. Painted and engraved stucco front; 3 storeys; quoins at sides and centre; one sash window with channelled lintel; slates. Modern shop fronts.*

*Nos 45 to 51 (odd). Railing and lamp standards of No 51 and Nos 55 to 69 (odd) form a group.*

*Late C18/early C19. Painted stucco front; 3 storeys; quoins at sides; one sash window (single glazing bars only); slates. Modern shop front. Included for group value.*

*Nos 45 to 51 (odd). Railing and lamp standards of No 51 and Nos 55 to 69 (odd) form a group.*

Address 85 High Street

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*C18. Stucco; 2 storeys; 2 canted bay windows tiered over 2 storeys; quoins at sides; blocked window at centre of 1st storey with semi-circular head, keyblock and "Gothic" glazing bars; slates; moulded wood pilaster doorcase with panelled reveals, 'Y'-traciated fanlight, open pediment and modern door. Canted bays at either side converted to modern shop fronts.*

Address 93 High Street - listed as Almswood House

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*C17. Faced in roughcast; stone plinth; 3 storeys; 2 projecting gables; 5 sash windows; central doorway has 9-panelled door, panelled reveals, cambered soffit, and wrought iron railings above to balcony fronting French windows; modern tile roof. Interior much altered, but retains contemporary staircase, having turned balusters, and some exposed ceiling beams.*

*Nos 93 to 97 (odd) form a group.*

Date listed 7 May 1977 amended 24 June 1977

### Description:

*Early/mid C19. Engraved stucco; 2 storeys; 8 sash windows in plain architraves; continuous moulded cornice at 1st floor; 2 plain doorways; slates. No 95 has altered ground storey with modern shop front.*

*Nos 93 to 97 (odd) form a group.*
