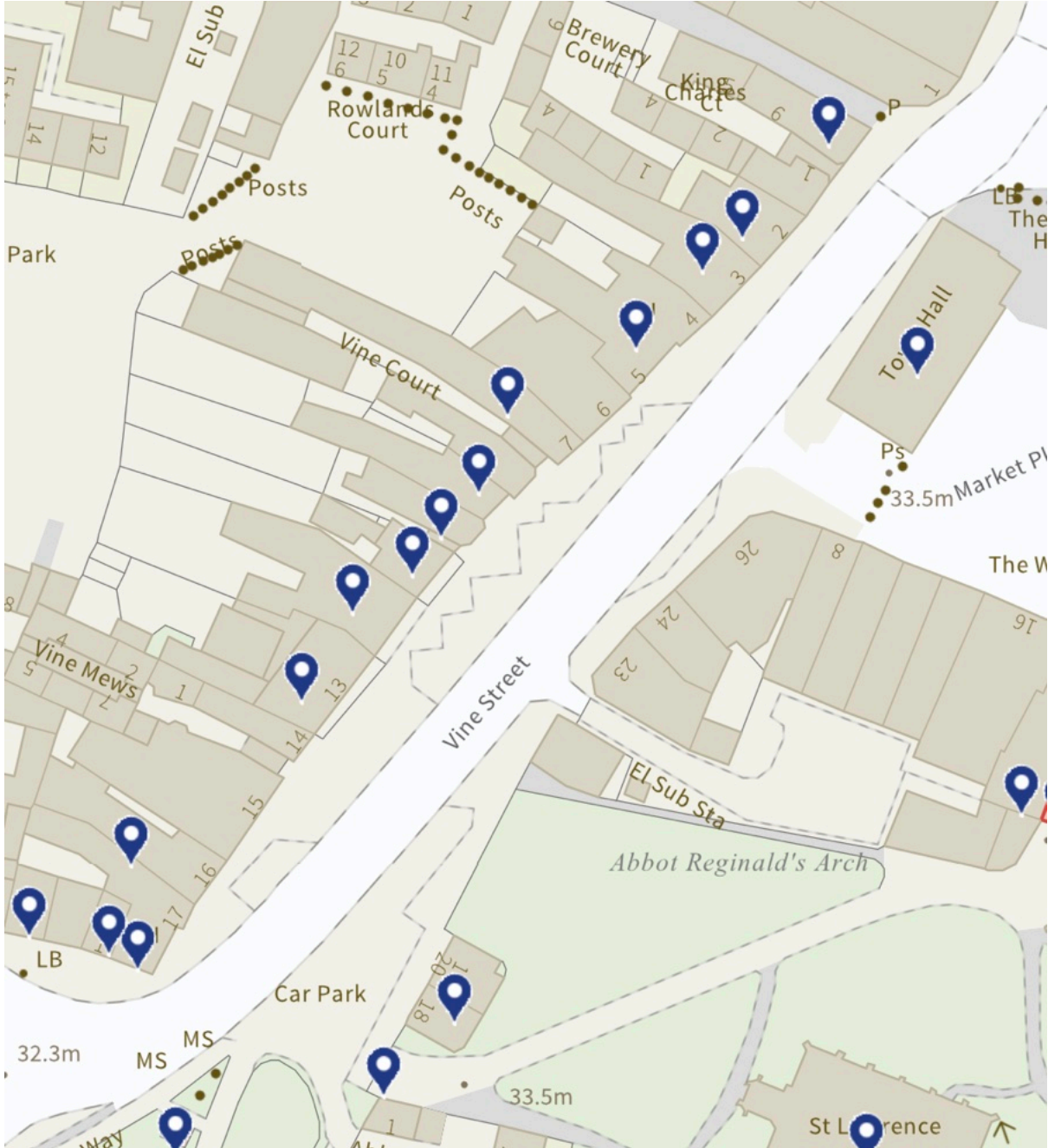

Address 1 Vine St, listed as King Charles II Inn

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

C18. Painted engraved stucco; 3 storeys; 2 sash windows; 3 sash windows to ground storey (one 3-light); modern wood pilaster doorway with cornice; good wood modillion eaves cornice; coped end gables; slates. Incorporates at rear a C15 or C16 timber-framed barn with good exposed timber roof members, infilling later rubble and brick. Rubble return wall to Bewdley Street.

Nos 1 to 5 (consec) form a group.

Address 2 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Late C18. Stucco; 3 storeys; fluted Ionic pilasters at sides rising through upper storeys; 4 sash windows with moulded architraves; eaves cornice and parapet. Modern restaurant front.

Nos 1 to 5 (consec) form a group.

Address 3 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

Late C18. Red brick; 3 storeys; 2 sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels; plain eaves; tiles. Modern shop front. Square headed passageway on left-hand side.

Nos 1 to 5 (consec) form a group.

Address 4 and 5 Vine St, The Royal Oak

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Modern sham timber frame and painted cement to earlier timber frame. 2 storeys; 3 gables; 4 modern casement windows. Modern inn front. Tiles. Interior much altered but retains some exposed ceiling beams.

Nos 1 to 5 (consec) form a group.

Address 7 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Early C19. Engraved stucco; 2 storeys; one sash window; slates. Late C19 shop front with modern glazing.

Nos 7 to 13 (consec) form a group.

Address 8 and 9 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Early C19. Engraved stucco; 2 storeys; 4 sash windows; slates. Modern shop front.

Nos 7 to 13 (consec) form a group.

Address 10 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

Probably early C19. Later alterations. Patterned cement rendering to former plaster front; 3 storeys; 2 sash windows, those to 1st storey with flat brick arches; slates. Modern shop front.

Nos 7 to 13 (consec) form a group.

Address 11 Vine St listed as Grafton House

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

Early C19. Red brick; 3 storeys; 3 sash windows, those to 1st storey with keyblocks and flat brick arches; slates. Modern canted bay windows to ground storey.

Nos 7 to 13 (consec) form a group.

Address 12 and 12A Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952 amended 24 June 1977

Description:

C18. Engraved stucco; two storeys; long and short chamfered quoins at sides; four sash windows with keyblocks and channelled lintels; stone plinth; parapet. Fluted wood pilaster doorcase with plain semi-circular fanlight, and open pediment. Semi-circular headed doorway on right-hand side with moulded stone keyblock, 'Y' traceried fanlight, and modern door.

Address 13 Vine St listed as Vinceroft

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

Late C18 or early C19. Stucco; 2 storeys; 2 sash windows and 2 modern casement windows. Ground storey has 2 three-light windows to left, a modern canted bay window (no glazing bars) and a pilaster doorway with entablature, rectangular fanlight, and modern door. Eaves cornice and parapet.

Nos 7 to 13 (consec) form a group.

Address 16 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

Faced in coursed cement rendering; 3 storeys; 3 sash windows with moulded keyblocks and plain lintels; moulded wood doorcase with panelled reveals, plain rectangular fanlight, small weather hood, and 4-panelled door. 3-light window on left-hand side of ground storey. Parapet.

Nos 16 and 17 form a group with Nos 1 to 7 (consec) and Old Grammar School, Merstow Green.

Address 17 Vine St listed as Old Red Horse Inn

Grade II Date listed 7 May 1952

Description:

C16. Timber frame with close set vertical members and roughcast infilling; 2 storeys; left-hand portion on stone base; 1st floor overhang; 3 C19 easement windows; tiles. Gabled return side has one window and overhang at 1st floor.

Nos 16 and 17 form a group with Nos 1 to 7 (consec) and Old Grammar School, Merstow Green.

Address 18-20 Vine St

Grade II

Date listed 24 June 1977

Description:

Early C19. Painted brick and painted cement; 2 storeys; 2 casement and 2 sash windows; chamfered long and short quoins at sides; 3 modern doorways, that to No 18 with pilasters and pediment. Modern multi-paned shop bay windows. Modillion eaves; slates.

Nos 18 to 21 (consec) form a group. (No 21 is of local interest).
